

## Virginia Spirits Board Launching Digital Spirits Passport September 1

Participants will check in to participating distilleries for a chance to earn prizes

**RICHMOND, Va. (August 24, 2023)** – On September 1, the Virginia Spirits Board will launch a digital Virginia Spirits Passport that encourages individuals to explore and celebrate the Commonwealth's unique craft spirits offerings and experiences.

The digital Virginia Spirits Passport is a free program in which all Virginians or visitors aged 21 and over can participate. The mobile passport is a curated collection of more than 20 Virginia distilleries, and more are expected to join throughout the year. It will run through August 31, 2024, with select distilleries offering unique deals and discounts guests can redeem during visits.
